BEST PRACTICES FOR TESTWE



Best practices for TestWe

1. Days before your exam

- Download and install TestWe **at least 72hrs before your first exam.**
- If you lose your **credentials**, click here: [Link](#) Enter your username and click [Forgotten password?](#) at the bottom right. Then, proceed to access the application.
- Make sure you are equipped with a **functional webcam.**
- Make sure your screen **resolution** is adapted so that no icons or buttons are hidden on your interface.
- Make sure your device is set to the correct time and date.
- You must imperatively have an **internet connection** for the first time of your login, the **synchronization** of your exam list, the **starting** of your exam and the **sending** of your exam papers. You can be offline during your exam.

2. The day of your exam

- Take you exam on the same computer you took the **technical prerequisite** on and send your submission through this same computer.
- On D-day, **log in** to TestWe **10 minutes** before your exam.
- **Deactivate** your **firewall** and **antivirus** before launching TestWe.
- You will need your **ID document** next to you to start the exam.
- You must have a **charger** with you in case of any battery issue during your exam.

YOUR TESTWE BEGINNINGS

Your TestWe beginnings

a. Installation

Starting from the welcome email received in your inbox (check your spam folder) :



Mac OS 10.13 (minimum) :

- click and drag the logo in the Applications folder
- open the Applications folder
- click on TestWe



Windows 10 (minimum) :

- follow the installer's instructions
- Make sure you are on an **administrative** or that you have the admin password in order to be able to install and launch TestWe.



Linux Ubuntu (20.04) :

- Right click on TestWe and select properties
go in « Permissions »
- check the case « Allow executing file as program »
- Right click on TestWe again and run the program



We **are only compatible** with **the operating systems** from the previous **list**.

If your computer system is not included in our list, we advise to get ahold of one as soon as possible in order to be able to take your exams.

Minimum system requirements :

- 4GB of RAM (8GB recommended).
- 1GB of free space.

b. Opening TestWe

Please **connect to the internet**.

Log in with your credentials received in your welcome email and go through the training test followed by your mandatory Mock Exam for all first-time log ins.

c. Synchronizing your exam list

Log in to TestWe at least **48hrs prior the exam** : open the software with an internet connection and make sure your exam(s) show in « Next exams ».

d. Technical prerequisite test



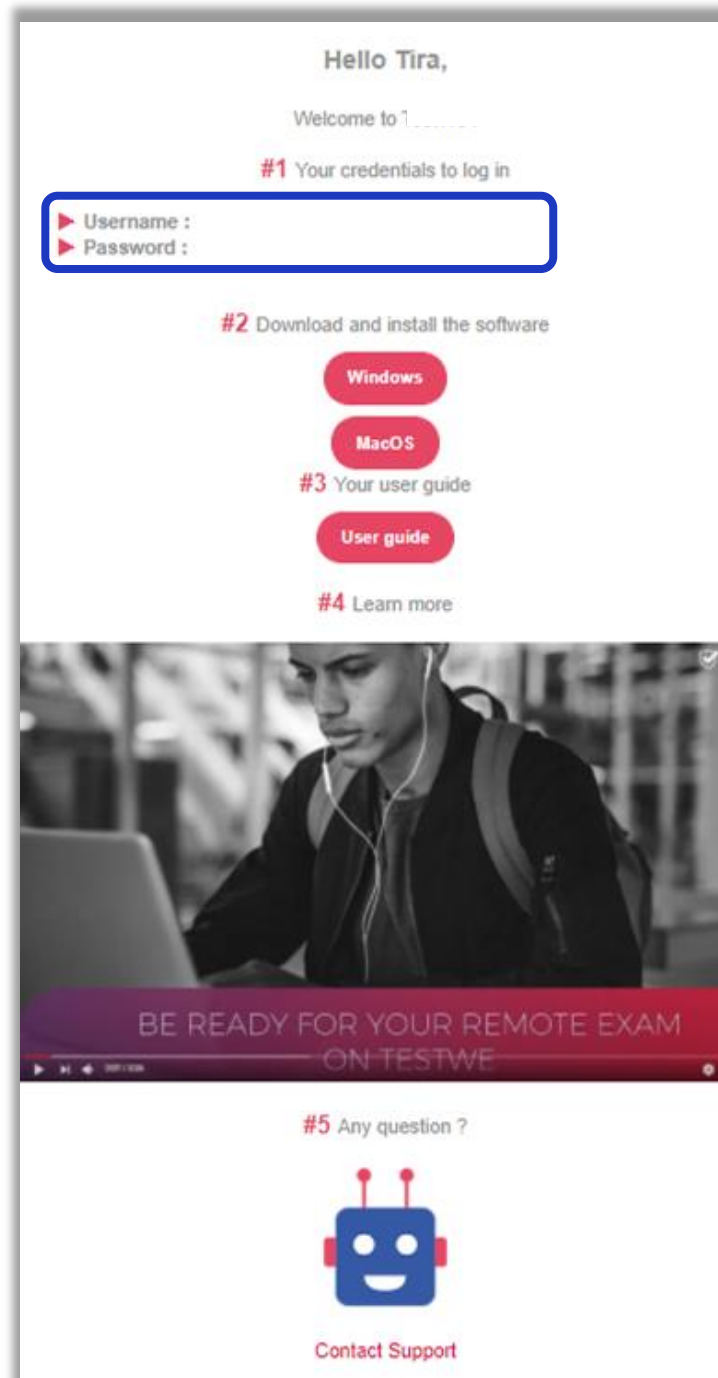
- Go through your technical prerequisite test at least **48hrs prior the exam**. This test allows us to verify the compatibility of your device with our app. The test is **MANDATORY**.

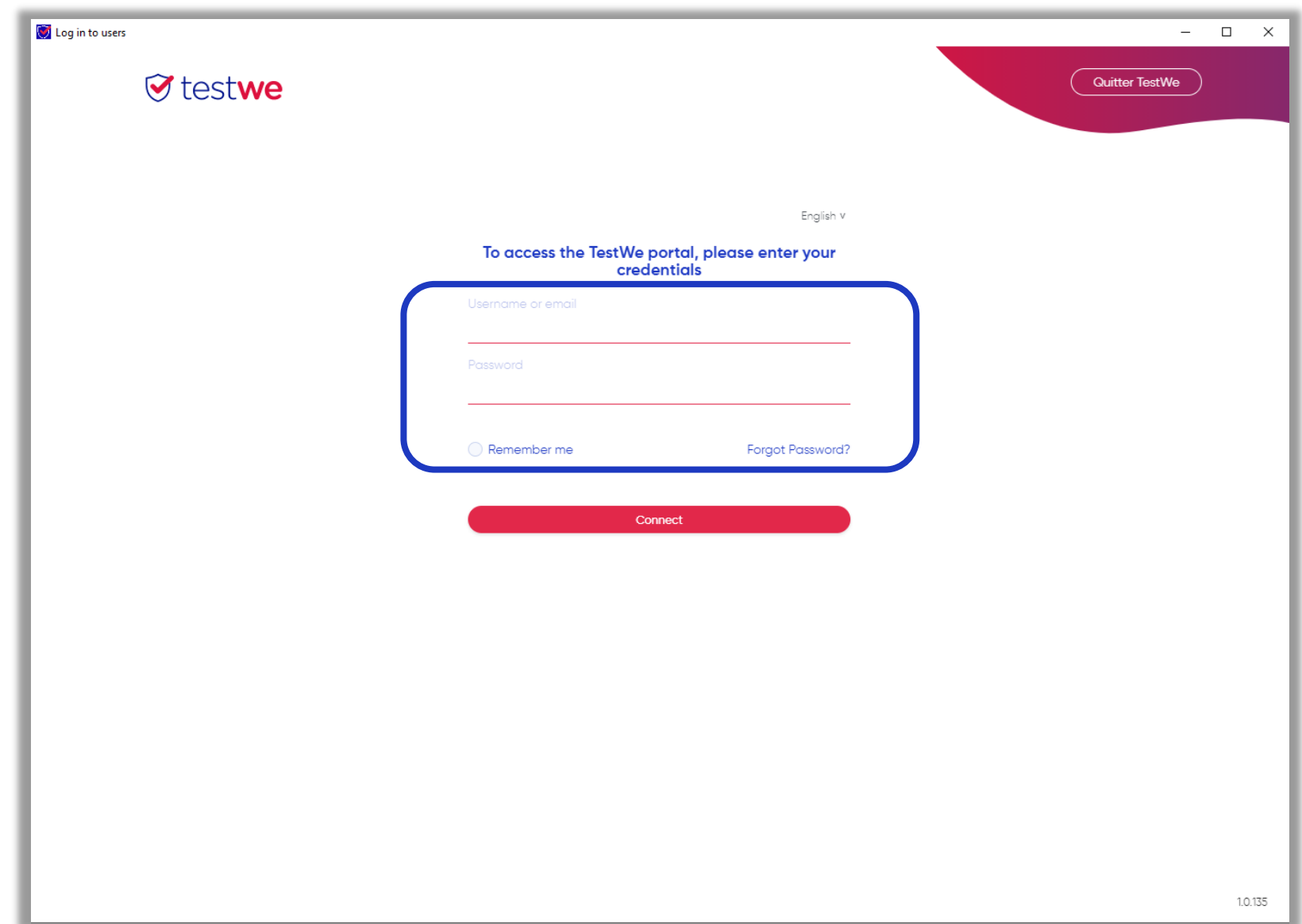
YOUR EXAM: STEPS TO TAKE ON D-DAY

a. Log in to the software

1 You can find your credentials in your welcome email.

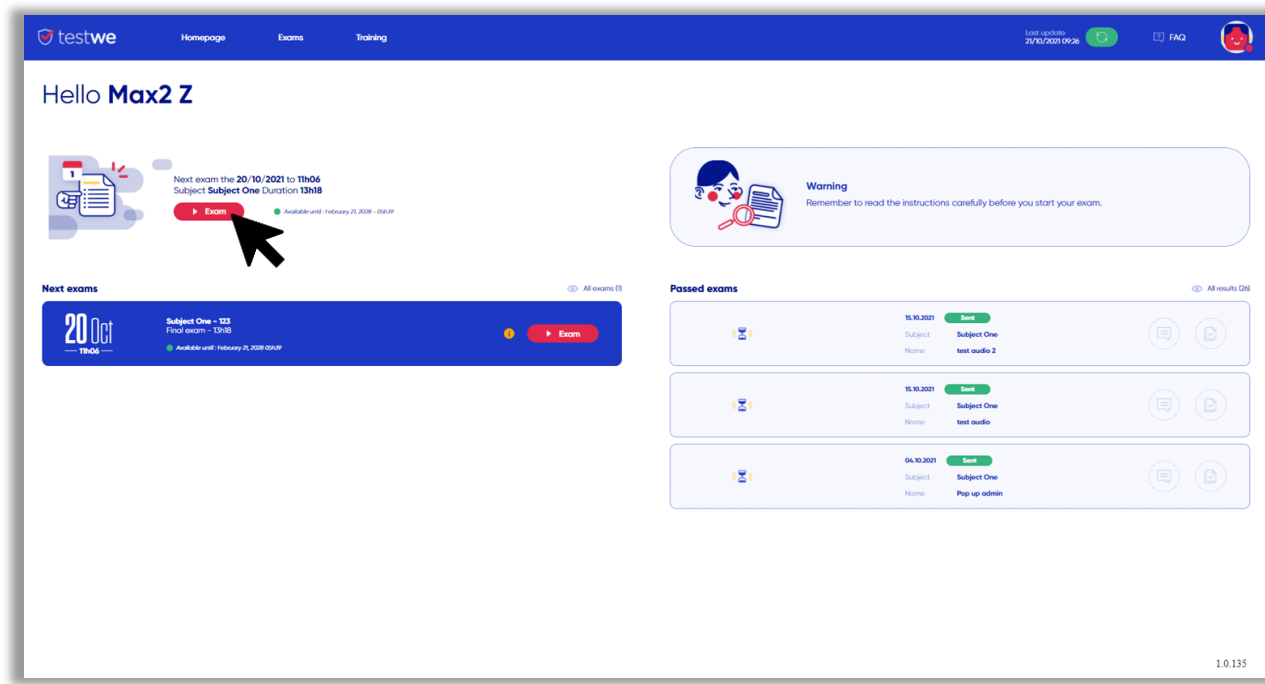


2 Insert them in the relevant field in the software to log in to TestWe.

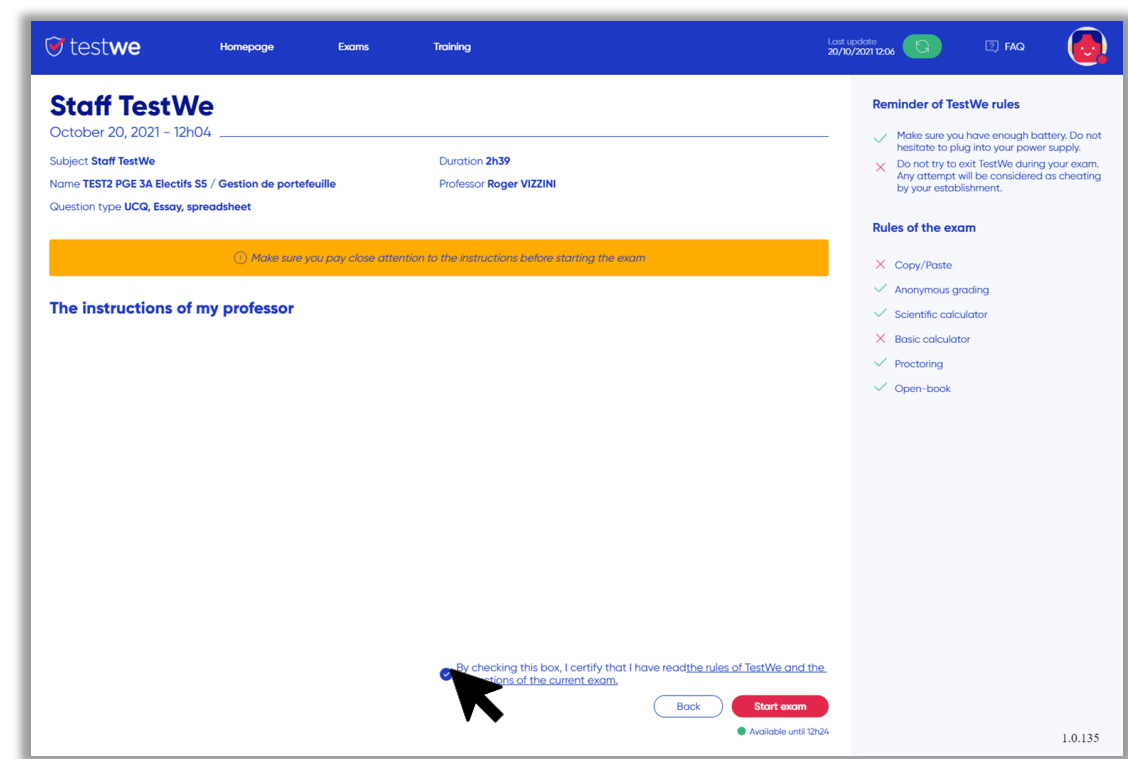


b. Start your exam

2 Read the rules and instructions of the current exam, and click on « Start exam ».

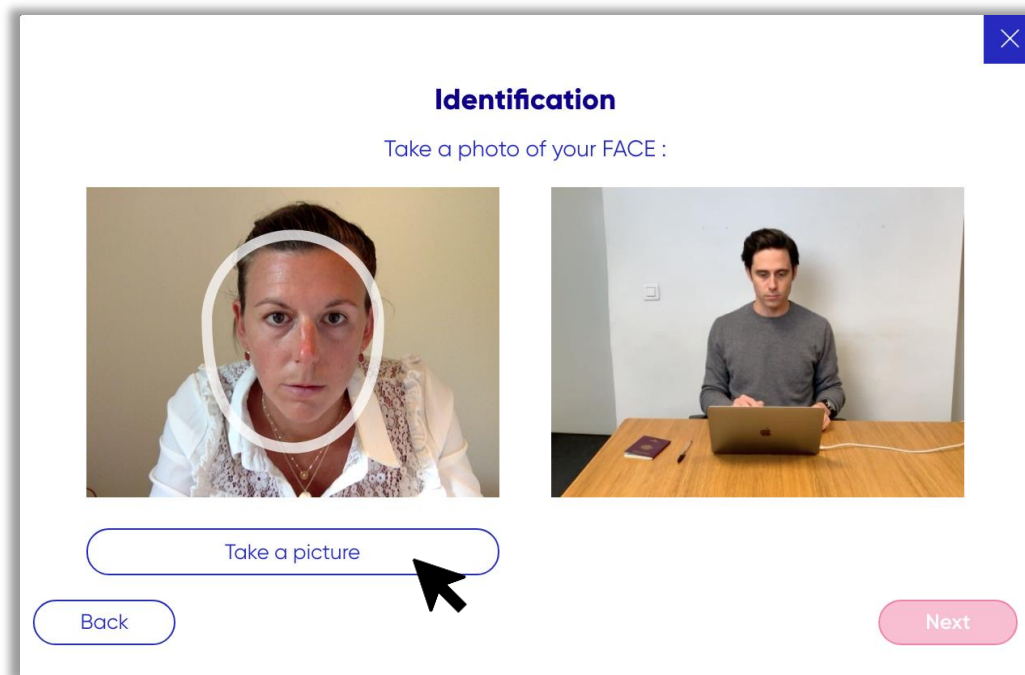


All your files and documents will automatically be closed as soon as you start your exam session (unless you are in an « open book » exam).

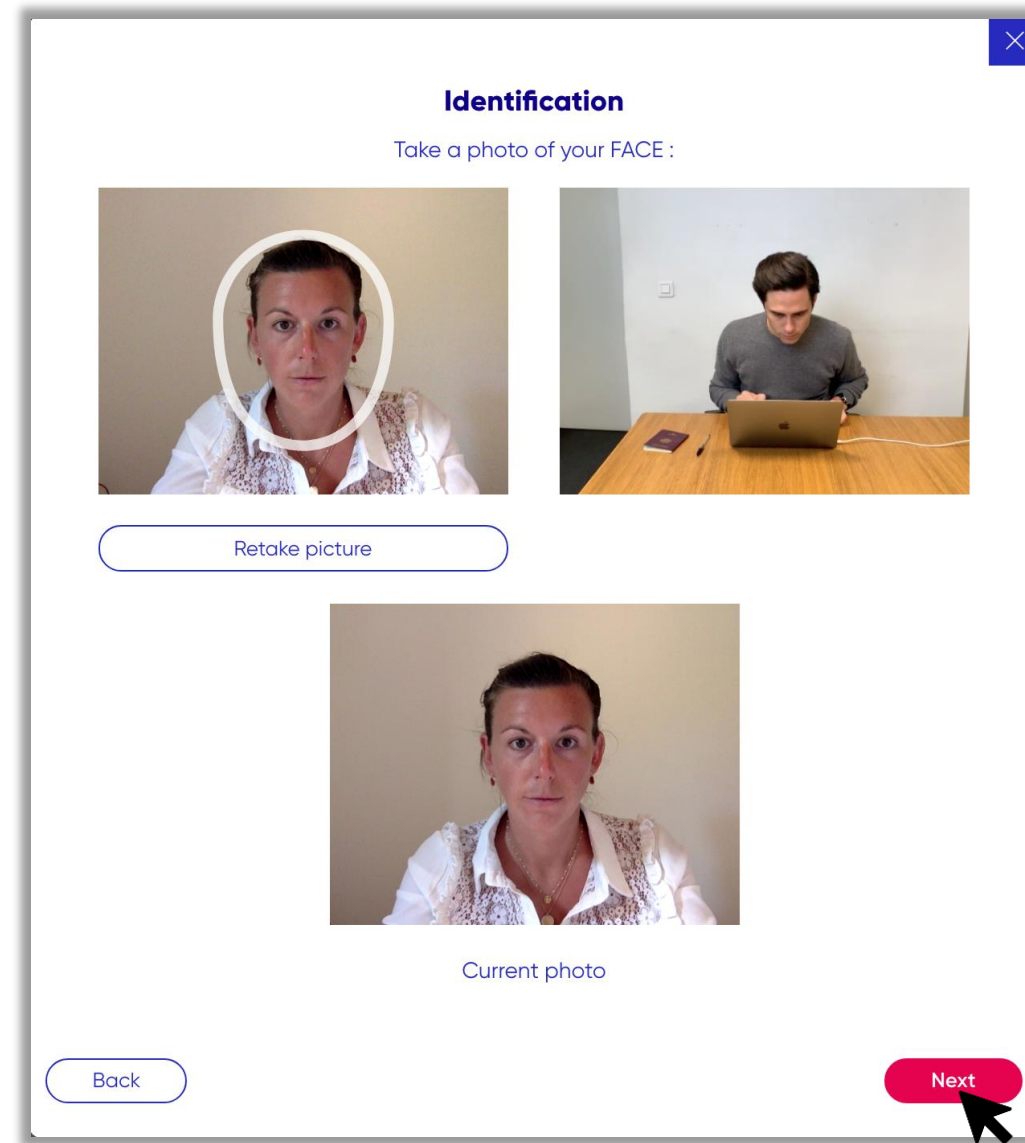
Don't forget to save all your work before launching your exam on TestWe.

1 Take a photo of your face through your webcam.

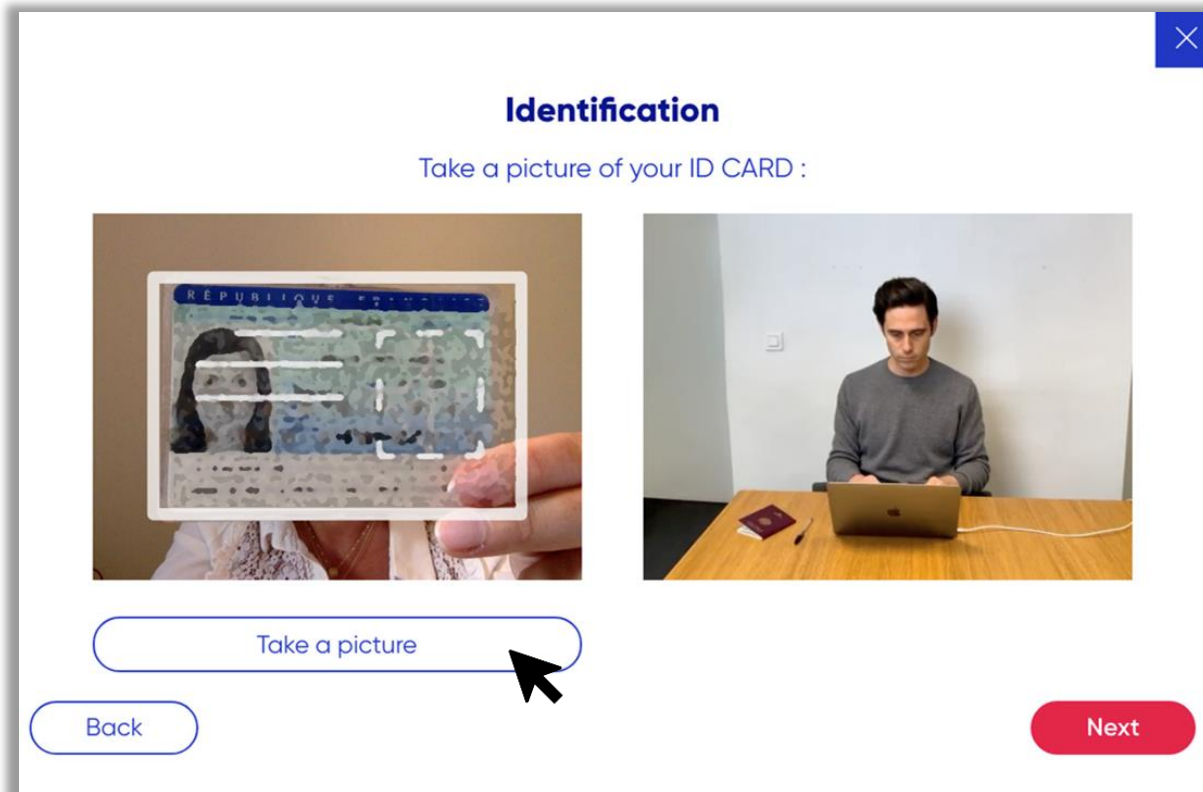


2 Validate the picture.

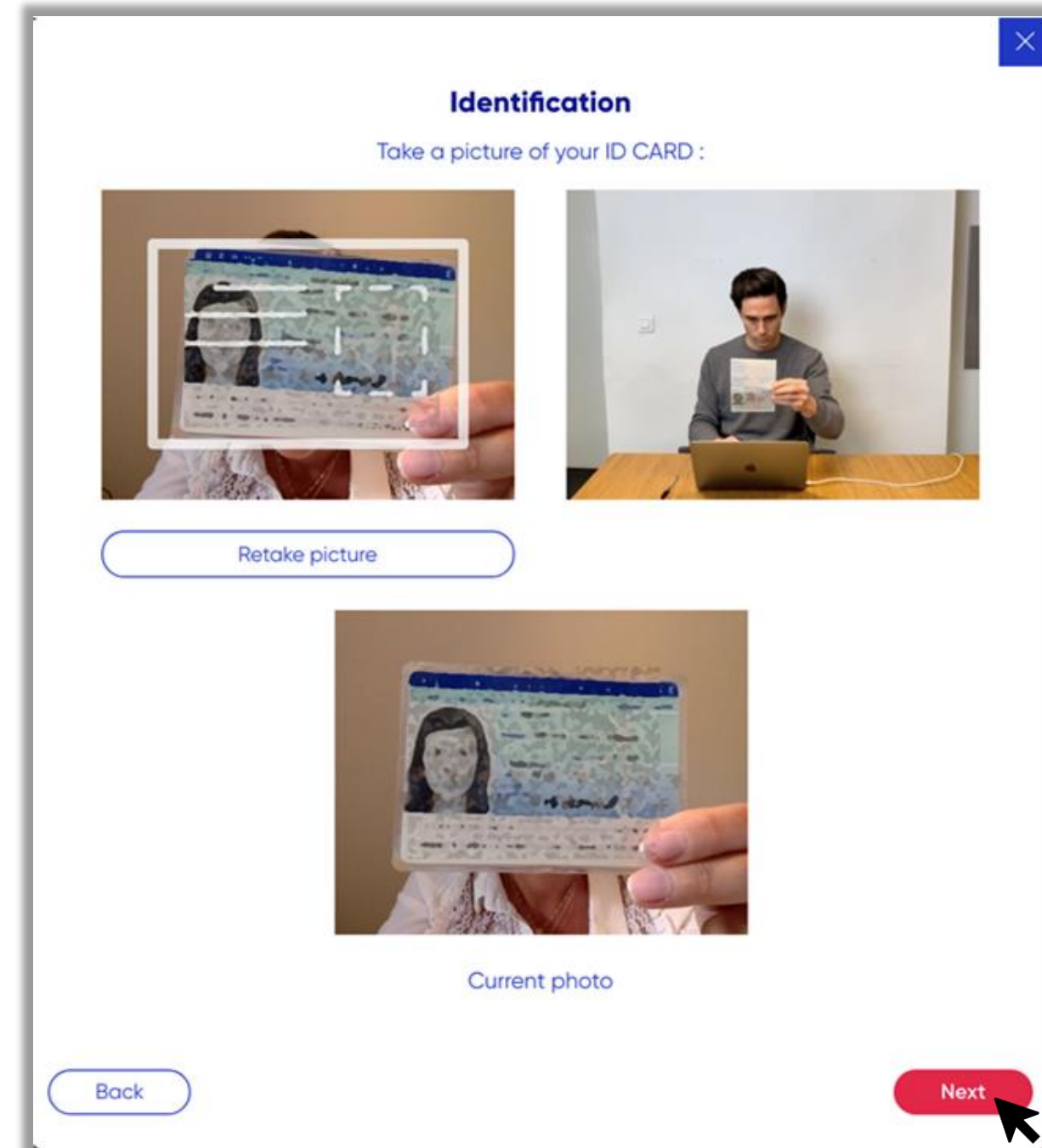


d. Verifying your identity

1 Position your ID card in the dedicated frame and take a picture.

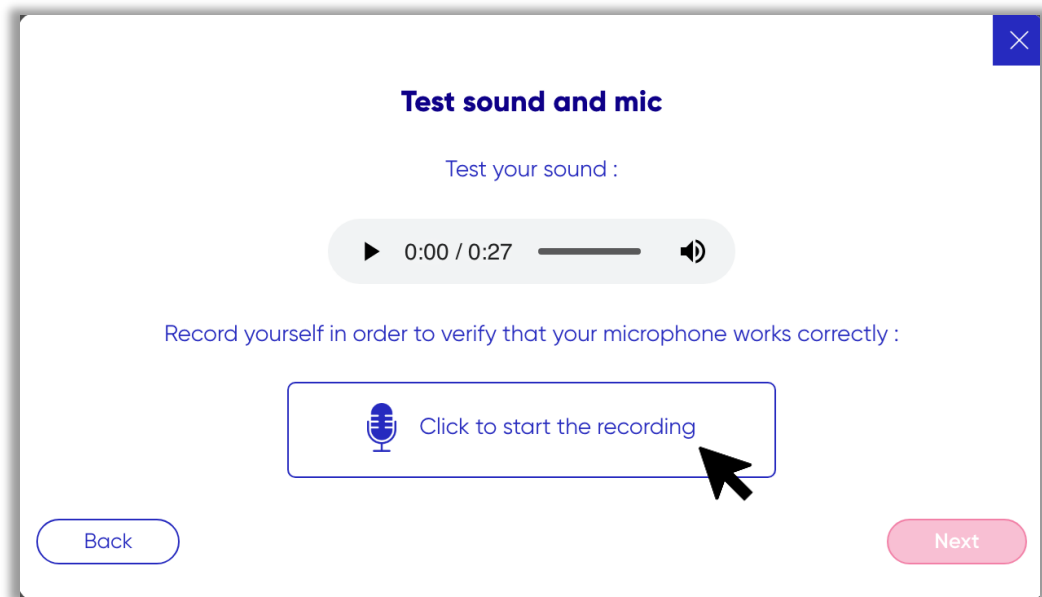

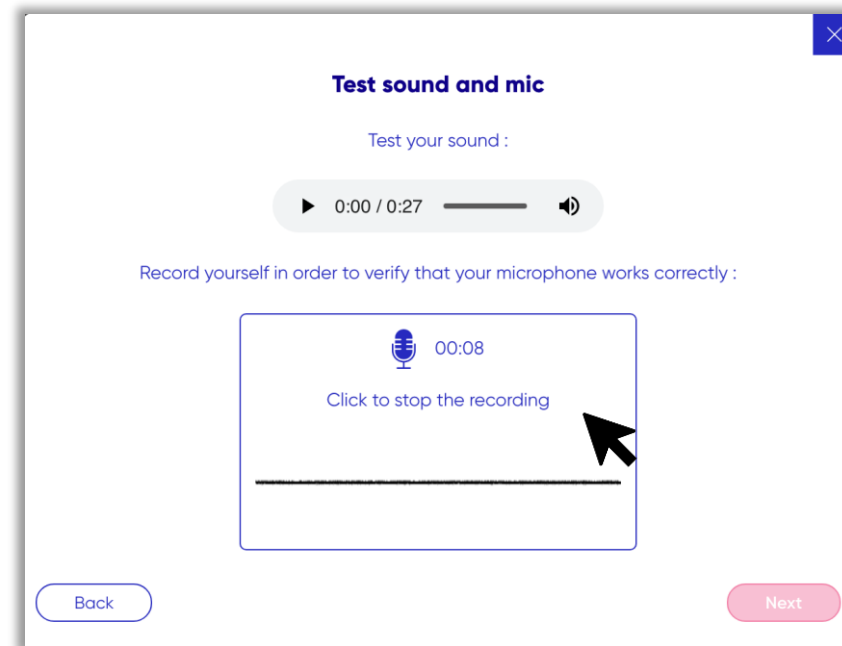


e. Verifying your microphone

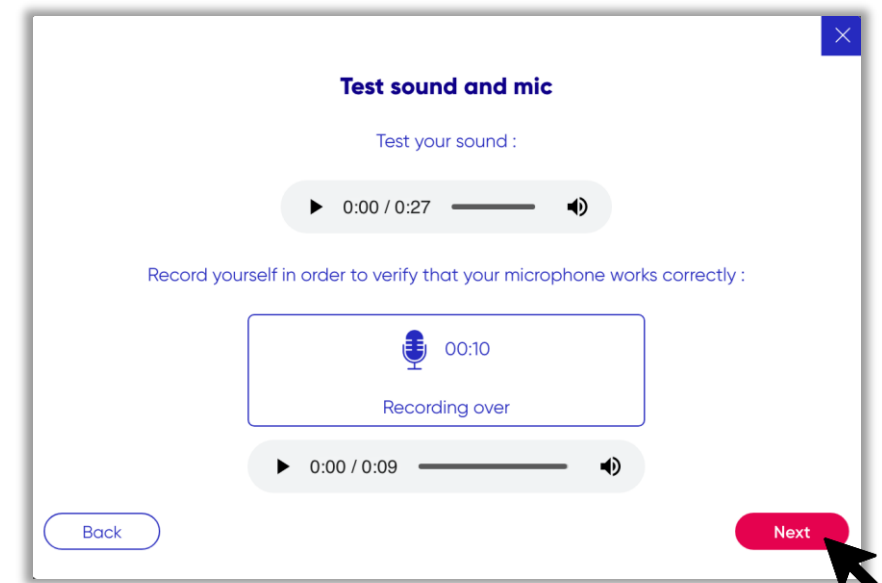
1 Click to record your voice.



2 Click to stop the recording.



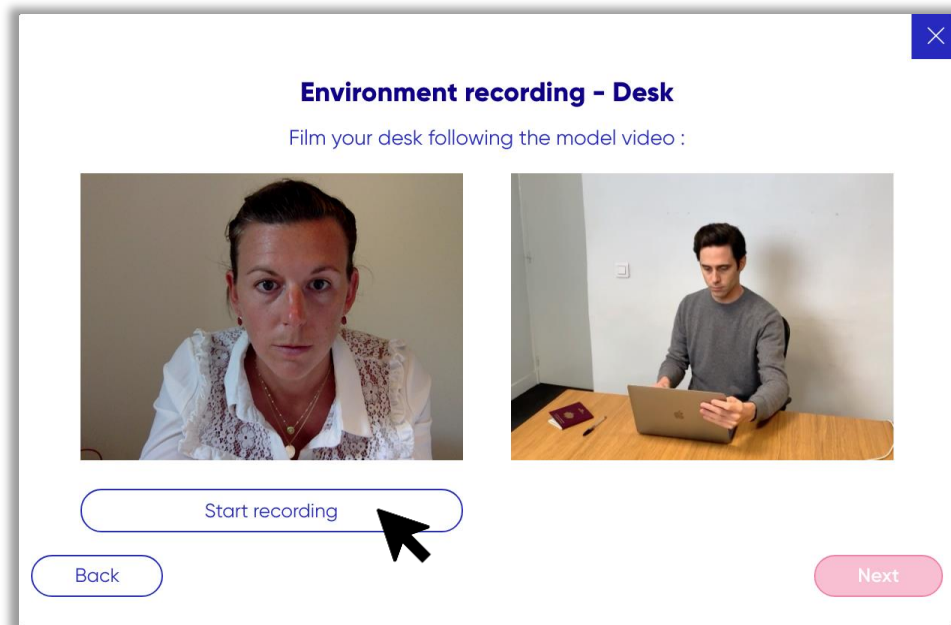
3 Click next to validate.



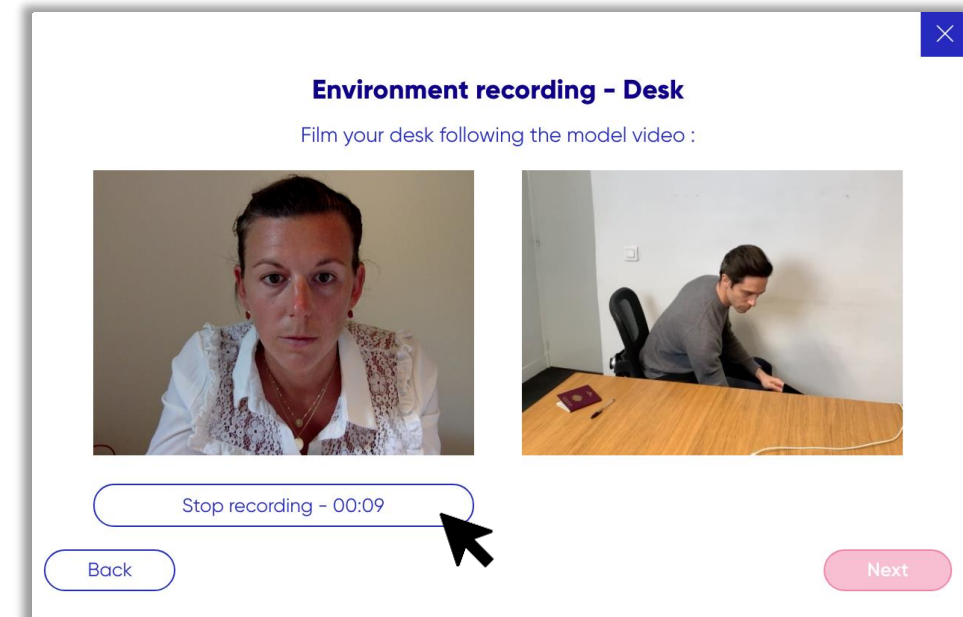
This verification step is only needed if your exam was set up with a microphone proctor.


3 Click next to validate.

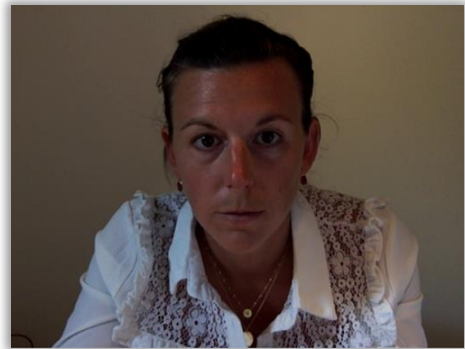

1 Your room must be well-lit.



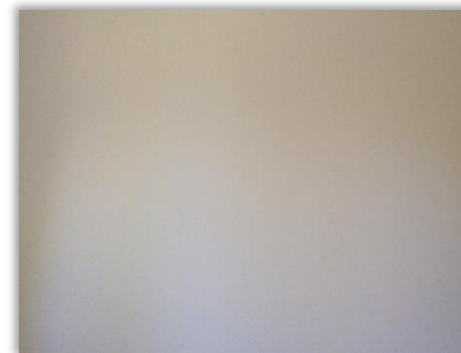
2 ID documents and computer **only** on the desk.

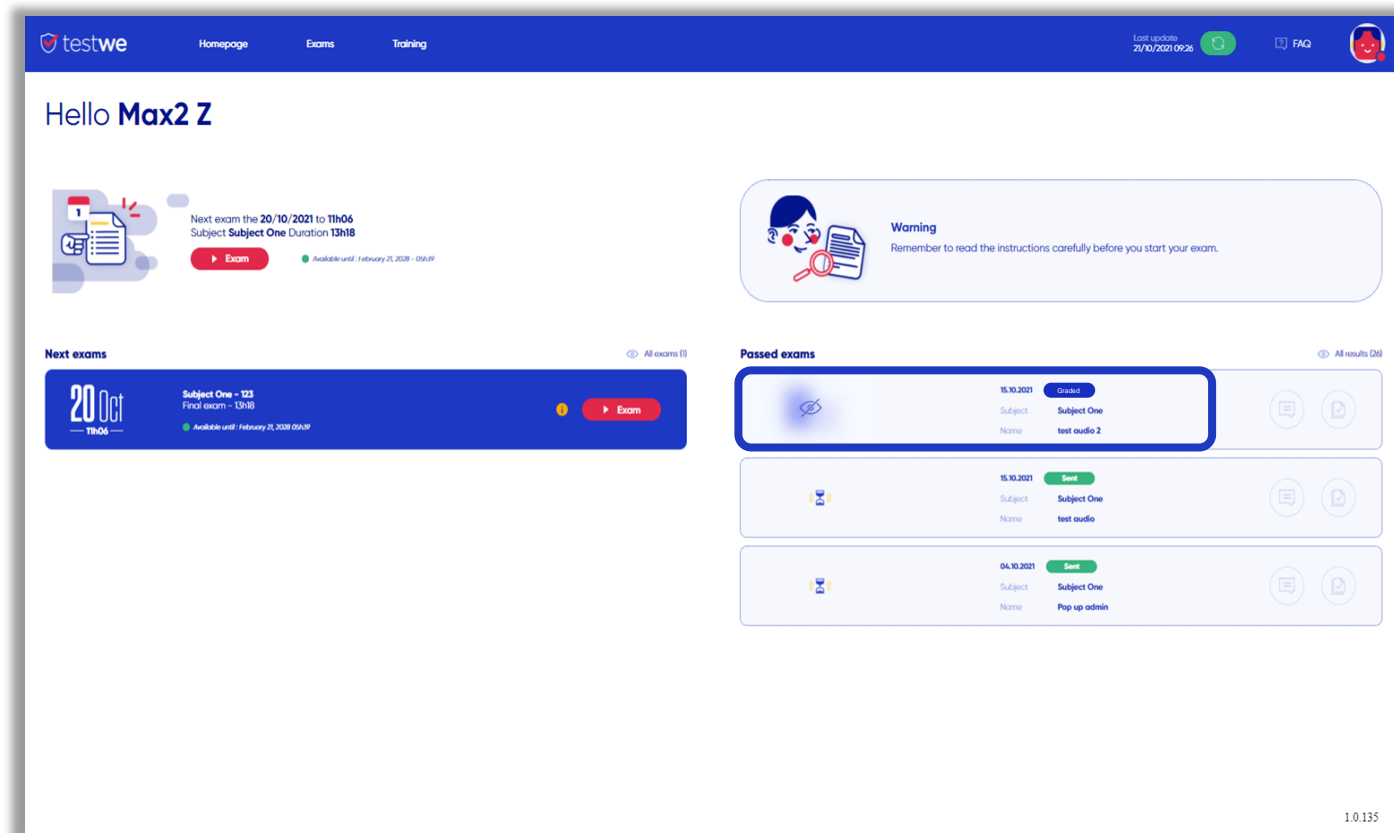
b. Receiving your results

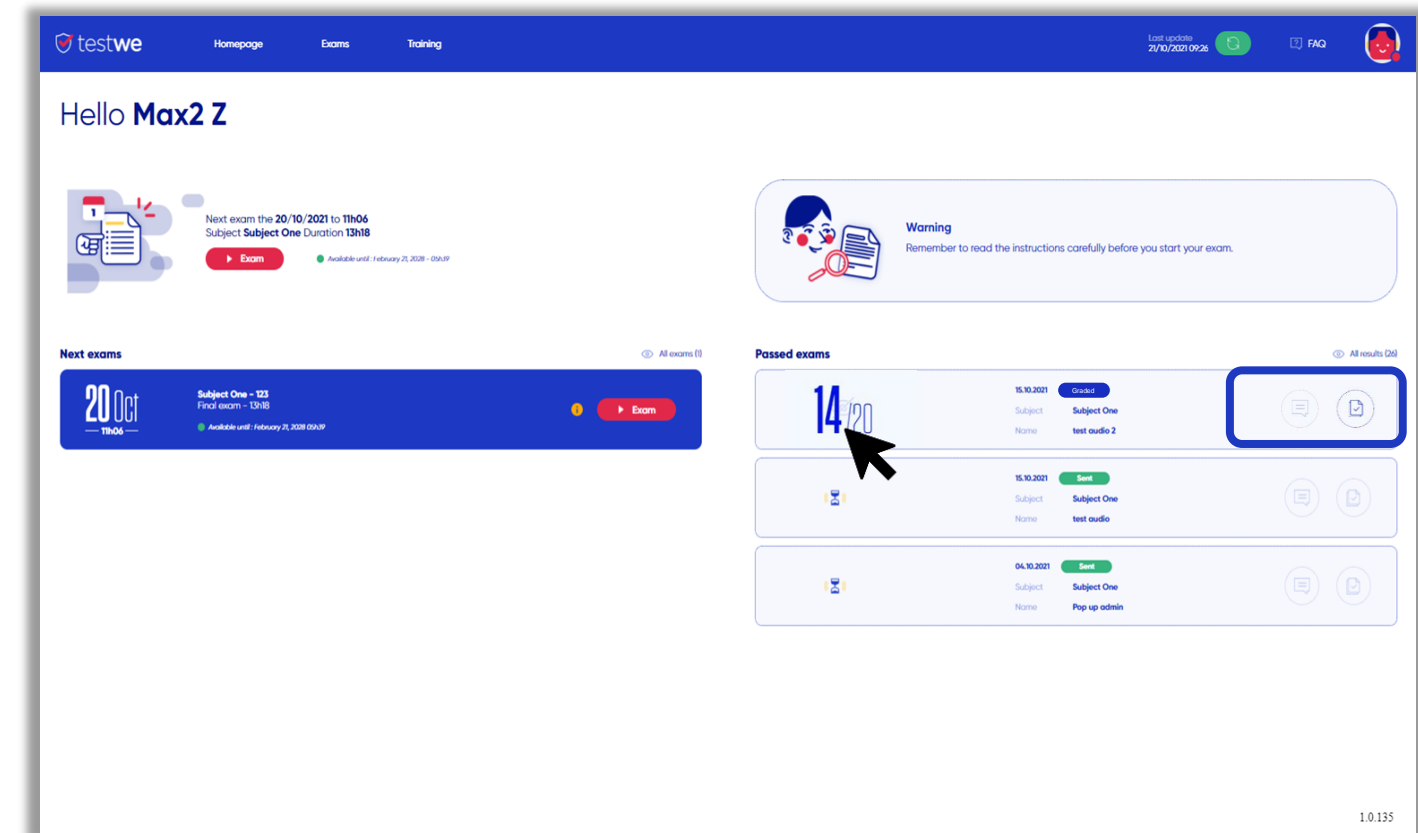


If the grade sharing is done through TestWe :
